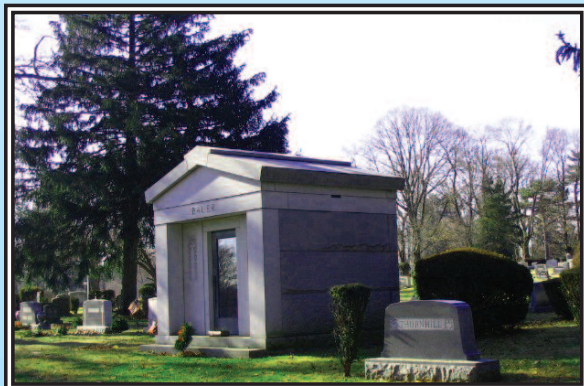

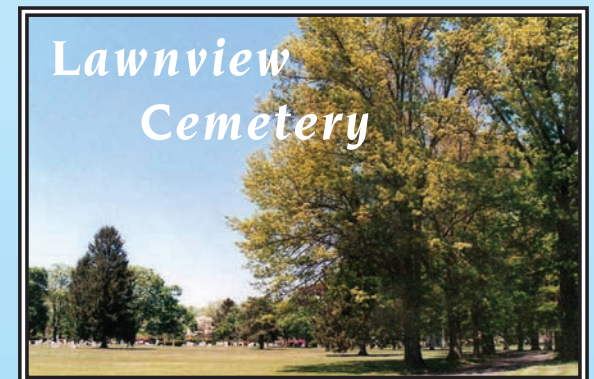

From Philadelphia: Take Rhawn Street west to Huntingdon Pike, bare right. Entrance is approximately .4 miles on the left. Alternate route: Route 73 west, (Cottman Avenue), turn right on Church Road. Turn left on Huntingdon Pike. Entrance on left.

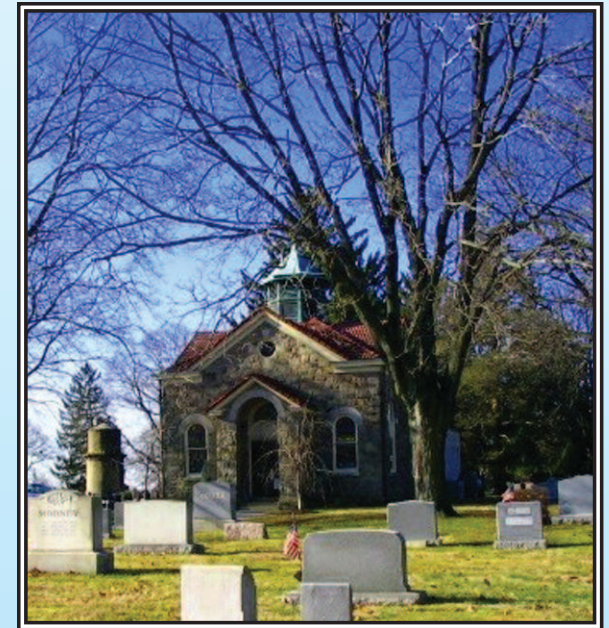
